On 3rd September, six Committee members attended the Merchant Navy Day Commemoration Service at the Mosman Art Gallery adjacent to the Mosman War Memorial, sponsored by Mosman Council. The service was led by MC and Merchant Navy Chapter Coordinator, Merrill Barker, capably supported by our sub-Branch Patron, Don Kennedy OAM, who is Immediate Past President of the Merchant Navy RSL sub-Branch, prior to it becoming a Chapter of Forestville RSL sub-Branch. We laid a wreath on behalf of Forestville RSL sub-Branch members.

Our RSL Auxiliary held a successful Meat Raffle in the Forestville RSL Club on Friday 23rd August. The Auxiliary raised \$581 with your support.
